Apple trees have beautiful _____ that open in spring. Other broadleaf trees have tiny flowers that you might not even notice.

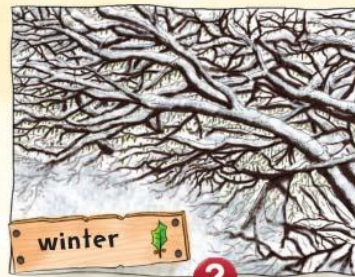
